






**Amendment to Sailing Instructions – Number 2 – 24 March 2019  
(This replaces Amendment No. 1 issued 25 March 2018)**

**2. SAFETY**

2.2 Competitors in the Informal Dinghy Race are required to sign back in on their return if no finish has been provided.

**6. CLASS FLAGS**

The class flags for the new recognised classes will be:

RS Feva	Code Flag F	
2000	Code Flag K	
Singlehander Class	Code Flag E	
Merlin Class	Code Flag O	
Informal Dinghy Race	Code Flag J	

The Singlehander Class is for monosailed dinghies sailed by one person without trapeze or foils and a Portsmouth Yardstick Handicap number between 1025 and 1145.

This changes SI 6. All other Class Flags remain the same.

**7. COMMITTEE VESSEL STARTS**

The flags shown at the ISC Flagstaff advise the approximate location of CV Betivuka.

The approximate location of CV Transit is indicated on a whiteboard displayed by the Bandstand not less than 60 minutes before the proposed start time.

**8. COURSE**

Course Card Z displayed from the Bandstand indicates that a special course is displayed on the Official Notice Board.

**16. SCORING**

One competitor constitutes a race in the Singlehander class
