## Notice of Event

The St. Wilfrid's Hospice Coastal Yacht Challenge will take place on Saturday August 31, 2013. St Wilfrid's and the organising club, The Inn-Shore Cruising Club, cordially invite private and club entries for this event.

These predicted times are BST and are for guidance only.

### Rules

The Challenge will be governed by the RULES as defined in RACING RULES OF SAILING 2013 - 2016.

### Classes

Boats will be divided into classes based on handicap.

### The Course

The course will be approx 12 nautical miles from a mark near Chichester harbour entrance around the NAB, finishing according to the final instructions.

### Start Times

The start times will be from 12:45 Hrs. (BST).

### Sailing Instructions

Final instructions and pennants will be issued at a meeting in The Shore Inn at 18.30 Hrs. on Friday August 30th, 2013.

### Trophies

Winners will be awarded in each class and one overall. There will also be a trophy for the Club whose combined entries do best.

### Winners

Will be chosen for sailing prowess AND fund raising ability COMBINED.

# St Wilfrid's Hospice

This event is a sponsored yacht challenge from Chichester Bar around the NAB Tower and back (12 nautical miles), designed to raise funds for ST WILFRID'S HOSPICE.

**While there is the opportunity to compete against others and points are awarded according to finishing position, the event is not seen solely as a test of sailing ability.**

## How It Works

- Skippers are required to make their pledge on the evening before the event at a pre-challenge briefing which will be held at The Shore Inn, beginning at 18:30, Friday, August 30, 2013.
- Boats are divided into classes and will be issued an ISCC Handicap TCF figure by the Challenge Committee.
- Your finishing position will be achieved by multiplying your elapsed time in the Challenge by your handicap (TCF or time correction factor), which gives your corrected time.
- Points are then awarded on a sliding scale for each class, the boat with the lowest corrected time receiving 10 points, the second boat 9 points, the third boat 8 points down to the last boat with 1 point. Boats that retire will not receive any points.
- These points are then multiplied by the amount pledged on the Friday evening to give the Total Points and thus determine the class and overall winners.
- Trophies are awarded to class winners and the overall winner. The Tempus Fugit is awarded to the club with the highest Total Points.

There are plenty of serious racing events in the area, catering for all sailing abilities. If however you would like to put something back into the local community and have a fun weekend while doing so, then WELCOME ABOARD.

# Coastal Yacht Challenge

## Saturday August 31, 2013

### Challenge Disclaimer

A boat and the owner and the person in charge (the boat) are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the 'Notice of Challenge' or the sailing instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the boat to decide whether it is fit to sail in the conditions for which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea, the boat confirms that it is fit for these conditions and that its crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

The boat is required to hold adequate insurance for this event, and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of a boat. Nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat having taken part in the challenge. The organisers encompass everyone helping run the challenge and the event, and include the organising authority, its officers and staff, the challenge committee, the 'Race Officer' and assistants, the patrol or rescue boats and beach masters.

The provision of patrol or rescue boats does not relieve the boat of its responsibilities. The fact that a challenge committee may conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities set out in this paragraph.

#### Insurance

In addition to third party liability for not less than £2,000,000 referred to above, competitors are advised to affect their own personal accident cover.
