WEST ZONE NAMED 25TH RYA ERIC TWINAME CHAMPIONSHIPS

It was the RYA West Zone who reigned triumphant at Rutland Water this weekend as they were crowned 2011 RYA Eric Twiname Champions as the Regatta came to a thrilling finish on the final day of the Championships (Sunday 8th May). With light breezes greeting the opening day of the Championships on Saturday, stronger winds ranging from 20-25 knots and spells of sunshine throughout the day (Sunday 8 May) enabled the 327 sailors to compete in exhilarating conditions allowing for the 2011 Eric Twiname Champions to be crowned.

In clinching their prestigious victory the West Zone also won the Eric Twiname Dinghy Trophy, awarded to the zone performing best from the top 2 dinghy classes out of



the 5, while the North for the second year running retained the Eric Twiname Windsurfing Trophy, awarded to the Zone scoring best from two of the four windsurfing classes. Dave Woodhead, RYA West Zone Coach, commented: "Our kids have had a fantastic weekend incorporating all the hard training they put in over the cold winter months in order to come out Championship winners and to take home the Eric Twiname Shield. It's excellent to be crowned top RYA Zone as well as winning the Eric Twiname Dinghy trophy and the win here at Rutland bodes extremely well for the future."

The RYA Volvo Zone/Home County Championships will take place at nine regional venues over the weekend 24 & 25 September.

The event is the RYA 'Regional Championship' for each zone and is aimed at all sailors in local clubs under the age of 16 who are racing in the RYA pathway classes. It is a great first time event for club sailors, giving them the opportunity to get a feel of a championship atmosphere.

For first time three of the zones and all Home Counties Championships will offer 'novice' regatta fleets in Toppers and Optimists.

This is a event for sailors to set themselves as an end of year goal after training and racing over the year this Summer. It will give the young sailors a good learning experience to help start them along the pathway to success.

Volvo get some of the Volvo Team for Life sailors to attend some of the events, where they meet the young sailors and chat about their sailing career from club level, to first regional event and how they progressed to elite level. All events are supported by coaches and international judges giving advice and help throughout the weekend.
